As you recall, the original brick *Pathway to History* was part of an ambitious plan to make Smith-Cadbury wheelchair and handicapped accessible. The original blueprint was to create a path from the bank parking lot to the side entrance of our building. An ADA compliant restroom was also planned. When the bank no longer agreed to us using space in their parking lot, we attempted to visualize a path at the front entrance. This proved quite difficult design-wise, not to mention prohibitively expensive thereby relegating the plan to the back-burner, as they say. For now, we'd like to offer you an engraved brick in the pathways here at Smith-Cadbury. We have extensive brickwork paths and patios surrounding our beautiful historic building and we're excited to add engraved bricks that commemorate a special occasion or a special person and serve as a memento for future generations.
